Make the Most of Your Visit to Jerusalem's Old City

Beginning this month, visitors to the Old City of Jerusalem can enjoy discounted access to local attractions and museums.

Thanks to the new HolyPass smart card, visitors can save on admission to ancient Jerusalem's most fascinating attractions as well as enjoy a host of benefits and discounts at area restaurants and shops.

With the pass, families and groups save up to 25% on admission to Old City at-

tractions. Discounted access is available at a choice of five attractions, including such sites as the Ir David National Park, Machon Hamikdash, the four Sephardic shuls, the Old Yishuv Court Museum, Tzidkiyah's Cave, and others (all sites must be checked, of course, for *shemiras Shabbos* and appropriateness of contact).

Additional discounts include:

- Nighttime Kosel Tunnel tour for individual pass holders

with just two days' advance reservation (compared with booking weeks in advance without the pass)

- Discount on the Jerusalem city tour route No. 99 double-decker bus

- 10%-15% discount at selected Jewish Quarter cafes and restaurants

- Up to 10% discounts in Jewish Quarter and Cardo shops

For just NIS 99 (\$25)

for adults and NIS 50 (\$13) for children, pass holders also receive free local maps and a travel guide. Further assistance is available to visitors at the Tourist Information Office at Jaffa Gate, whose phone number is (02) 627-1422.

HolyPass can be purchased at participating tourist sites, hotels, Jewish Quarter shops and through travel agents. Group passes are available through travel agents at special prices.
